SERMON TITLE: Seeing

MAIN POINT:

Jesus has called us to not only see people's pain and hurt but to move towards it.

Scripture: [Luke 13:10-17](#)

Principles for studying a passage of Scripture:

- ✓ **Comprehension:** Asks - What does the passage say?
 - ✓ **Interpretation:** Asks - What does the passage mean?
 - ✓ **Application:** Asks - How should this passage change me?
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Questions:

- **Comprehension:** Read Luke 13:10-17 together. How would you summarize this passage in your own words? What would you say is the main point?
- **Personal Reflection:** What sticks out to you most in this passage and why? What causes questions?
- **Comprehension:** Why were the synagogue leaders upset with Jesus?
- **Comprehension:** According to Jesus, why were the Pharisees guilty of hypocrisy? Explain.
- **Interpretation:** How do you think this woman's disability affected her physically and spiritually?
- **Interpretation:** How do you think this woman's disability influenced her identity? Do you think she saw herself as a "daughter of Abraham"? Why or why not? Explain your answer.

➤ **Interpretation:** What do you think Jesus was hoping to teach the crowd by setting this woman free? What did he want to teach the Pharisees?

➤ **Application:** What in your life “disables” you from having a vibrant walk with Jesus? Or from being effective in the Kingdom? Be honest and specific!

➤ **Application:** Read verse 16. Do you see yourself as a child of God? Why or why not?

➤ **Application:** Do you see others as a child of God? Why or why not?

➤ **Application:** Application: Look at verses 10-13 again. How can we begin to pray expectantly, knowing that our God is able, even when we don't fully believe He will answer us?

➤ **Group Prayer:** Take some time to pray intentionally with and for each other. Pray expectantly, that God would free us from those things that disable us in our walk with Jesus. Pray that we would find our identity in Christ alone.

Personal Questions (for monthly breakouts):

➤ What life challenges are you facing this week?

➤ How are you responding to those challenges?

➤ How can we pray for your heart in those challenges?

➤ What sins are you holding onto right now?

➤ How can we help keep you accountable?

➤ How can we be praying for you personally this month?

➤ Share one way God has been working in your heart and life this past month!
